One of the CSA, CSC, CST elective courses will fulfill the requirement for BUS 101 First Year Seminar for Business Students. If a student takes the CSA 105 Introduction to Software Applications to fulfill the BUS 101 course at Western New England University and CST 258 Fundamentals of Internet Programming, then one of the CSA, CSC, CST electives will be unassigned.
